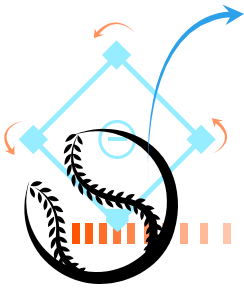




SOFTBALL LOTTERY EXEMPTIONS



1. Prior year waiting list individuals who were priority one last year and meet priority one criteria for the current year.
2. Coaches plus the individual they sign-up with to play on the same softball team.
3. Softball Chairperson plus the individual they sign-up with to play on the same softball team.
4. Softball Assistant Chairperson(s) plus the individual they sign-up with to play on the same softball team.
5. Tournament Director plus the individual they sign-up to play on the same softball team.
6. Coaches who have coached the prior three consecutive years and are not coaching the current year.
7. Sponsors (subject to a separate sponsor lottery, if necessary) plus the individual they sign-up with to play on the same softball team.
8. Former Softball Chairpersons, of at least two years, will be exempt for life following the conclusion of their term.
9. All individuals have to be priority one to qualify for an exemption.



SOFTBALL PRIORITY GROUPS



Priority One

- All members who have paid their dues by the second meeting in October of the current Columbus Ski Club fiscal year (September 1 - August 31) and sign-up the first night of softball sign-ups.

Priority Two

- All members who have paid their dues after the second meeting in October of the current Columbus Ski Club fiscal year and sign-up the first night of softball sign-ups.

Priority Three

- All members who become members or renew their membership on the night of softball sign-ups and sign-up for softball that same night.

Priority Four

- All members who sign-up after the first night of softball sign-ups.





NOTES:

1. Priority groups and lottery exemptions are subject to change based on sign-ups and balancing of the teams.
2. Players and/or NPA's signing up together will be assigned to the lowest priority group of the two individuals.
3. Beginning with the 1996 Softball Season, players and NPA's who fail to attend nine regular season softball games or do not attend the Columbus Ski Club softball tournament without a valid excuse will have their priority lowered one group in the next year they sign-up for softball. Excuses will be evaluated by the Softball Committee on an individual basis.
4. Players and/or NPA's requesting to participate together must both put the others name on the sign-up form.
5. Players and/or NPA's requesting to participate with more than one other player or NPA will have their request disregarded.
6. Please designate a night to play softball or the committee will select the night that best balances the teams.
7. All players desiring to participate in softball must have a current rating. A current rating is obtained by attending the current year softball rating clinic or by having participated in at least one of the last two years of Columbus Ski Club social softball. Any questions should be directed towards the softball committee.
