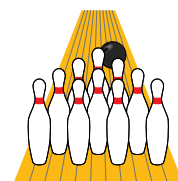

"Racing? Me"? Yes, you! Whatever level skier you are now the race program can make you better. It's only \$70.00. And look at what you get:

Get In Shape: The race program is a complete "get ready for the ski season" curriculum. We start off on Sundays with our dry land training. These ski-specific conditioning workouts help prepare you physically for the rigors of skiing. Practice, practice, practice: Our first practice is in December (see race schedule) Taught by certified racing instructors, the CSC Race Team Program can take your skiing to the next level. The race coaches will emphasis basic turning skills during practices. These lessons alone are worth the cost of the program!

Friendly competition: Don't be intimidated! The racing program is what you want it to be. It can be a platform to that next level of skiing. It can be a great way to make skiing in Ohio fun again. For some it is friendly competition against their buddies. For the rookies it is a sure fire way to do all of the above plus make some long lasting friendships.

All in the family: Make racing a family event. Children of Columbus Ski Club Members can join the Junior Race Team for \$70.00. A parent, legal guardian, or authorized adult member of the race team must be present on race day and during practices.

And that's not all: Other fun activities are planned throughout the season. Things like Karaoke at some of the Friday night practices, a cookout (at the top of the hill) on our last race day, and our end of the season blowout to recognize the outstanding performances of the year. Other things to look forward to are, The Coaches Challenge, a top-to-bottom race at the back bowl of Clear Fork. The CSC will be hosting The Cup Race this year the festivities include an awards ceremony with a buffet dinner at The Holiday Inn in Mansfield. 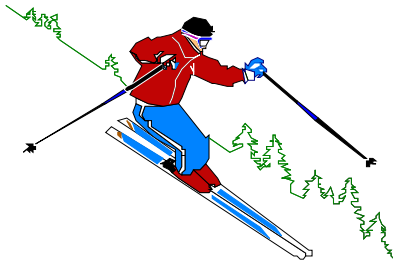
